- -Which modules can be replaced by the offers of the partners (This should be figured out before the meeting so we can put this information on our website already. Please check how this was done for Karlsruhe: http://www.botanik.kit.edu/eucor/78.php)
- -How to inform students about the offer? (This might be different for each partner university but we should agree on the information that is given.)
- -What is the benefit for the students (Is there anything we can offer beside the certificate? How will the certificate look like, how do the students get it and do they have to participate modules in all three countries to get it?)
- -What steps are necessary for the students if they want to use the EUCOR offer from the first contact to the achievement of the certificate? (Experience shows that students are easier to motivate if the organization is clarified in detail.)
- -How to organize travelling and accommodation?
- -Is it possible to take examinations/write protocols in English for modules which are not offered in English?
- -There should also be a point on our EUCOR page with organizational matters, which lists all the information that are relevant for students to get started. For example weblinks to the campus maps or a checklist.
